Age related expectations

End KS2

- 100% of pupils entitled to Pupil premium are working at age related expectations or above in reading
- 100% of pupils entitled to Pupil premium are working at age related expectations or above in writing
- 100% of pupils entitled to Pupil premium are working at age related expectations or above in maths

Enhanced Impact

- Children have access to more small group intervention time
- High quality resources purchased for teaching English & Maths (but especially focused on resourcing interventions)
- Higher levels of engagement & motivation through use of quality resources
- Development of resilience in order to promote better health and well-being

Summary of objectives for Pupil Premium Funding 2015 - 2016

To raise the attainment and progress of pupils so that children make at least expected progress and close the gap enabling pupils to reach age-related expectations through:

- Fund cost of Teaching Assistants to deliver specific interventions
- Purchase specific resources to impact upon needs of individual pupils
- Behaviour support for individual pupils
- Provision of social & emotional support/interventions to improve social skills and behaviour
- Provide access to wider opportunities through curriculum opportunities, after school clubs and activities & help to finance cost of educational visits
- CPD for staff to support social skills & emotional well-being

£20,000	Teaching Assistants – Interventions	Continued funding towards costs of TAs within KS1 and 2 to support focused intervention work.	High numbers of PP pupils requiring basic skills interventions e.g. reading, maths, gross and fine motor skills developments
£10,000	L3 Enhanced TA	Y6 Booster	Increase levels of attainment at end KS2
£4,000	Resources	Lexia Accelerated Reader Dynamo Maths	Increase achievement and attainment in reading and maths. Increase pupil engagement, motivation and enjoyment
£200	CPD for staff e.g. Relax Kids	Upskill staff in ways to support pupils emotional well-being	Develop pupil resilience and ability to cope with challenge.
£500	CPD Accelerated Reader,	CPD for coordinator and English lead	To enable the most to be made of Accelerated Reader within school to impact upon attainment.
£3,000	Speech & Language support	Weekly sessions with targets children in reception	To improve levels of speech and language in preparation for transition to Y1
