

## PE at Bearpark Primary School 2017/18

- To raise number of pupils attending intra and inter school competitions
- To purchase new resources so that curriculum can be taught effectively
- To fund transport for pupils to attend inter school competitions
- To increase the number of non mobile pupils

### Measuring the impact of PE spending

- SLA agreement provided 52 hours of curriculum support for teachers increasing their confidence in the delivery of quality PE and sport across the school. Support was provided for the teaching of Fundamental movements, Net and Wall games, invasion games and dance
- PE Lead give 3 hours strategic support to help plan Active 30 and daily mile initiatives
- 178 participants took part 11 intra school games at Level 2
- Pupils accessed 6 new sports at Level 2 that weren't accessed in 2016/17
- Greater success in inter school competitions with Bearpark winning intra school football and runners up in Tag Rugby and Netball competitions
- 12 pupils accessed fundamental movement intervention programme to aid gross motor skills
- EYFS and Nursery staff accessed weekly curriculum support for Foundation Stage Fundamental movement to increase staff knowledge
- 39 weeks of Change 4 Life club provided provision for non-active pupils to access regular extra curricular physical activity. 3 pupils who previously classed as non-active became regular members of the netball team following Change 4 Life
- Achieved the Silver National School Games Mark award for 2017/18 which shows a strong commitment to school sport
- KS2 pupils engaged in leading, managing and officiating Level 1 intra school game events
- Raised the profile of PE with corridor display and weekly sport reports in achievement assembly
