

Phonics/Spelling

English

- Write your address. Discuss with your child what each line represents. Who delivers the post? Share a letter with them and explore the envelope – front/back. Ask your child to practise writing their address.
- Can you write a letter to a friend/family member or teacher? Can you write it in a letter format?

You can watch the daily lessons for week 3. We will be focusing on part whole number bonds, addition and subtraction and adding more and counting on within 20.


- Can you find ways of making 20 and write the calculation?

- Can you choose a number within 20 and count on until you reach 20. How many more did you need to count up? Can you write the calculation?
