Phonics/Spelling

Can you think of some compound words and draw a picture to represent them before you put them together (foot + ball = football) how many can you think of, and write?

Can you add -ing, -ed, and -er to words, such as jump which changes to 'jumping', 'jumped' and 'jumper'.

English: Using this image, could you write a setting description in sentences.

Does your sentence have a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop?

Could you include 'and' in your sentences?

You could write it in the first person as if you are on a journey on the boat. What can you see? What can you hear?
