



Bearpark Nursery Home Learning Tasks

Spring 2021 - Week 6	Today's task	Adult Input
Monday	Can you watch or read our story of the week? 'If I were an astronaut - story time from space' - YouTube	Ask your child What? Who? Where? How and Why? Questions. Comment on what is happening and ask your child what they think might happen next.
Tuesday	Can you do some yoga? 'Mike and Muttnik on The Moon – Cosmic kids yoga' - Youtube	Can you copy the moves on the video?
Wednesday	Can you make moon rocks and count as you throw them? For children due to start school in September can you make number cards and match the amount of rocks with the numbers 1 to 5?	Use tin foil or paper to make small balls, ask your child if they can throw them to you and catch when you throw it back. Then count how many time you can throw and catch until it falls on the floor. For older children write the numerals 1 to 5 and ask you child to place the correct amount of rocks on each numeral.



Thursday

Can you copy the dough disco moves? – YouTube

If you have no access to play dough, you can use a squashy ball or just some tissues. You can find a recipe for homemade play dough on our website under 'home learning Nursery'.

Friday

Can you make a mud pie?
Collect different natural objects, use an old pan, a spoon and some mud.

Explore the great outdoors! Encourage your child to discover different textures, sounds, smells and the change in weather.

Ask your child what they would like to make? What 'ingredients' do you need? Why? How would you like to cook it? In the oven, hob, microwave. Use different vocabulary such as mix, stir, roll, press, scoop, tip, pour...



Challenge Yourself!!

Can you do 10 mins of dancing a day?

Ask the children to choose 2/3 dances from Koo Koo Kangaroo on YouTube.
We do this every day in Nursery to keep active!
